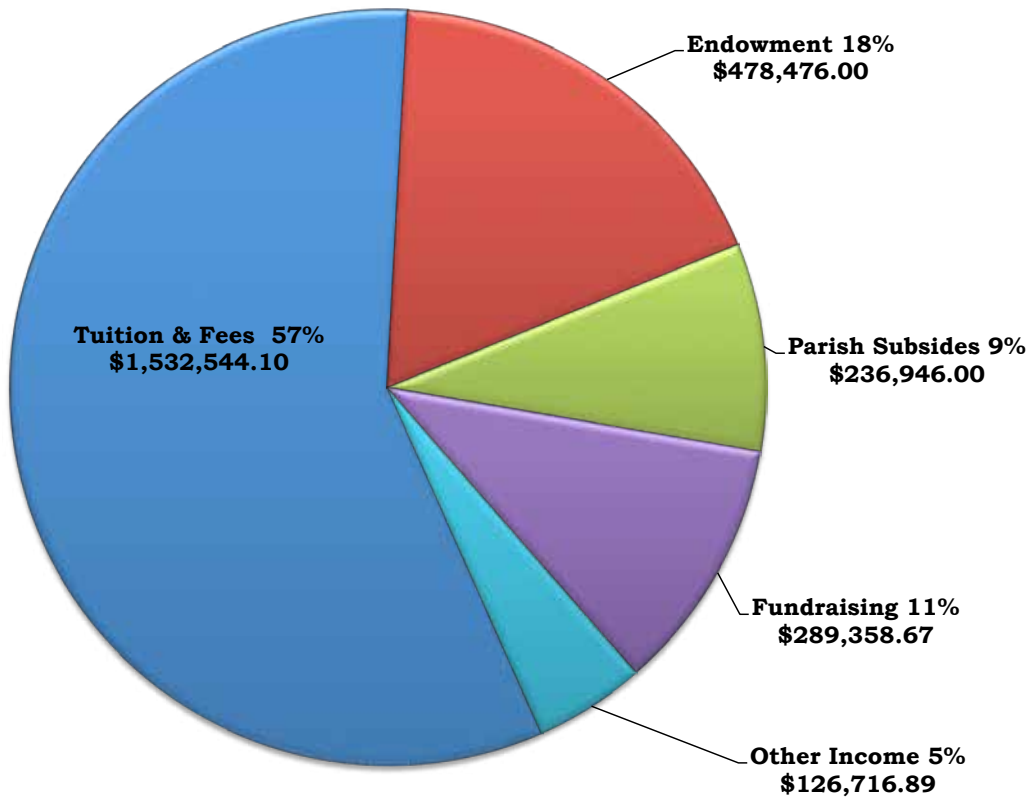

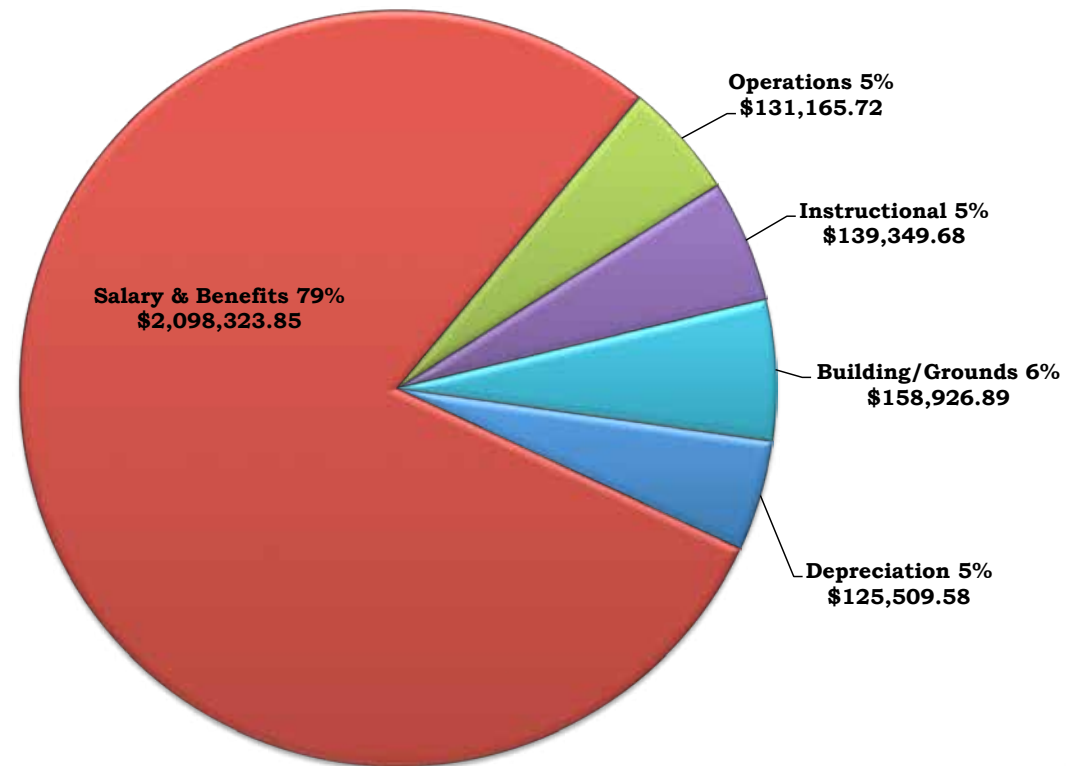

Academic Milestones and Achievements for 2012-2013

- For the past 12 years, **DeSales** has graduated **100%** of our students.
- Emphasis on **community service** grades 6-12.
- **\$2,395,424 in Scholarship money** was earned by the 2013 senior class. 16 of the 27 graduates received at least one scholarship. (**59%**).
- The ELC partnered with Early Achievers to obtain the **highest quality rating** in childcare and preschool.
- Partnered with WWCC Culinary Arts for **hot lunch program** at Assumption.
- SCRIP Program **raised \$25,000** for WWCS operating budget.
- The ELC offered **smaller preschool classes** with more bilingual curriculum.
- Annual **spiritual retreats**, grades K-12.
- Grades K-7 participated in the **S.A.M (Safety Always Matters) program**.
- All students K-7 involved in **MAP (Measurement of Academic Progress) testing**.

The ELC continues to thrive as we gain clarity of vision in the educating of young children. We have implemented more bilingual curriculum in an effort to expose children at a time when their minds and their language skills can benefit most. The smaller class sizes have been a key component in the success of our programs.

The environment is conducive for learning and children feel welcome. Our facility has joined with Early Achievers to rate our services and care. Early Achievers, Washington's Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS), is Washington's voluntary program for helping early learning programs offer high-quality care. We are following the Environmental Quality Rating Systems. We collaborate with Early Learning professionals in the area to meet these standards and we are working towards obtaining the highest possible rating. This will culminate with a visit and observation from professionals at the University of Washington. It is inspiring and motivating to be working with them to achieve this goal. This will be a tremendous amount of work in the upcoming years. It will require trainings, classes, conferences and observations.

I am proud of all my staff for embracing this work. We look towards the future with hope and excitement as we continue to implement changes that better serve our children and their families.

Athletic Wrap-up 2012-2013

Athletics at Walla Walla Catholic schools helps enhance the culture of our schools. Each student athlete is given many opportunities to grow in virtue – which makes for great citizens. Thank you to all of our benefactors for providing our young athletes the opportunity to both compete and excel.

In fall 2012, our volleyball teams and football teams were very successful. The football team took a share of the league crown and made it into the quarterfinals – which placed them as one of the top eight teams in the State. They also won the second straight Academic Champion award, garnering the highest GPA of any team in the state. Our athletes were featured as 2B Seattle Times player of the week, UB player of the week, and Tri-City Herald player of the week.

During the fall we learned that DeSales' own Ryan Baumgart was chosen as the Washington State Wendy's Male High School Heisman contest winner. Wow – great job Ryan.

The success continued into the basketball season. Both the boys and girls made it into the District Tournament. The girls won the league, and the boys shared 2nd place. The girls moved on into the regional tournament in Seattle where they won their regional and berth to the state tournament. In Spokane, the girls played some of their best basketball, eventually earning 6th in the state – great job girls!

Two more State Championships for the Irish? Yes! The DeSales baseball team earned their second straight (and 18th overall) State Championship in Ellensburg. Coach Cox called the 2013 Irish baseball team “an absolute joy to be around” and “one of the best teams in school history”. The softball team won the league and the District 7-9 regional title. This took them once again to the state tournament in Yakima where they performed very well with a very young and extremely talented team. The future looks bright.

The track team sent 12 of 19 athletes to the State Track Meet in Cheney. They earned a 2nd in State, a 4th, a 5th, an 8th, a 9th and two 10th place finishes. Not to be outdone, the golf team won our other State Championship for the 2nd year in a row. Ryan Baumgart won the 2B boys championship for the third straight year. His sister Emily earned 2nd in State for the second straight year, and Jerod Konen earned 3rd in State.

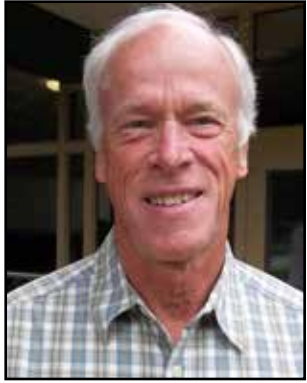
